GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Based in Richmond, British Columbia, at the TCWV Training Centre, and **under the direction of the Senior Team Head Coach and the High-Performance Director**, the NextGen Coach's main function will be to assist the National Team Program with the respective goals of producing elite athletes and international competition excellence.

It is understood that the responsibilities may change throughout the year or from year to year.

ROLES

The NextGen Coach is to act as an identifier and developer of talent through:

- The training and preparation of the athletes in the **National Excellence Program** (September to December)
- The use of **identification and monitoring** systems for all athletes in VC's development Pathway (January-March)

- Performance Analysis
- Reports

- In-depth understanding and application of the principles of coaching, sport science/medicine and technology within a high-performance program
- Ability to communicate in Canada's two official languages (English and French)

- Strong management skills
- Excellent understanding of the Canadian Sport System and its stakeholders
- Competent computer skills for communication, reporting and performance analysis
