



## **2022 TEAM ALBERTA – 17U INDOOR COACHING POSITIONS**

Volleyball Alberta is currently seeking qualified individuals for the following positions:

1. One 17U Women's Team Head Coach – Canada Cup
2. One 17U Men's Team Head Coach – Canada Cup
3. One Assistant Coach PER TEAM

### **Coach Role and Responsibilities – (but not limited to):**

- Involved in the selection and appointment of assistant coaches. Assistant coach applicants must also submit applications to Volleyball Alberta.
- Team administrative duties.
- Supervision of athletes in residence & training/competition venues throughout the training/competition period (at least one coach/team must stay in residence overnight with the athletes)
- Involvement in athlete identification including advanced scouting at Volleyball Alberta events and conducting talent identification during the months of February – May.
  - Identification camps are tentatively scheduled for April 23, with Selection Camps on May 28/29.
- Organization, planning, and execution of summer training schedule in cooperation with Volleyball Alberta high-performance staff and mentor coaches.
  - Summer training will run from July 2 – July 10<sup>th</sup>, and July 15 – July 19<sup>th</sup>. 17U teams will train out of Edmonton or Calgary, depending on coach and athlete personnel.
  - The preparation of your team for the Canada Cup tournament July 20-24 (Calgary, AB).

The coaches will work together to help select a larger group of athletes to attend the Team Alberta Identification Camp and Selection Camp. Athlete Selection Committee Members will work with Team Alberta coaches to select athletes to the competition teams.

Volleyball Alberta will facilitate a mentorship and professional development program to work with the Team Alberta coaching staff prior to and during the Team Alberta training period. This program will be an opportunity for some of Alberta's top coaches to learn from each other and train the province's top volleyball athletes.



**Criteria for Selection:**

- Head coaches- Advanced Development Certified, Performance Coach Trained or Certified, would be considered an asset.
- Assistant Coaches- Development Coach Certified and/or have playing experience at the CCAA, U Sports, National team, or professional levels.
- Previous coaching and related experience.
- Evidence of advanced technical and tactical knowledge in the sport of volleyball.
- Ability to lead an integrated high-performance training program.
- Previous commitment and contribution to the development of volleyball.
- Excellent communication skills with athletes, coaches, therapist, parents, and administrative staff.
- Performance in a formal interview (if deemed necessary by the Selection Committee).
- All applicants must meet Volleyball Alberta screening requirements
- Volleyball Alberta Coaches are required to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 by January 16, 2022 or hold a valid exemption and be able to comply with the Restrictions Exemption Programs of all venues used by Volleyball Alberta. Staff will be required to maintain fully vaccinated status while being employed by Volleyball Alberta.
