What staff/crew should expect at the VC Combine:

- Designated lunch break
- Training session at the beginning of each shift

- Become knowledgeable in all testing protocols and specialize in one specific station
- Provide feedback to assist in program development
- Receive a \$100 honorarium

Roles	Descriptions	Tasks
Registration	The registration crew will assist in the registration process.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist in the registration process (verifying athletes, registering walk-in athletes) • Assist with answering event questions • Direct athletes to starting area
Anthropometrics	Anthropometrics crew will assist in conducting 4 tests prior to the start of the Combine.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Height • Wingspan • Two-Hand Reach • One-Hand Reach
Station Support	Station support crew will assist the technical leads according to each station as well as learn the different aspects of each station:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Input each athlete’s data onto their sheets • Assist with retrieving balls for spike attack and serve velocity • Must have experience with tossing for attack velocity
Data Input	The data input crew will assist with the management of data entry of each athletes results after the Combine is completed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist in the input of data into Kinduct
