



## 2020–21 Volleyball Canada Referee Fees

Considering the ongoing nature of the COVID-19 pandemic and the overall impact it has had on sport, the National Referee Finance Committee has conducted a review of the 2020–21 indoor referee registration fees. The nature of the review was specifically focused on two variables relating to the pandemic.

1. The uncertainty of a regular return to competition
2. Potential financial impact that the members of the refereeing community may have endured or could face moving forward

In completing the review, the finance committee has determined that a change in the indoor registration fees for the 2020–21 season is warranted to create an equality amongst all referees during the pandemic. To facilitate this change, all referee committee registration fees related to indoor volleyball for the 2020–21 season will be waived.

In addition, the finance committee recognizes that some referees may choose not to register due to the pandemic. Under normal circumstances, the Referee Policy manual states:

- Any referee that does not register with their PTA or with Volleyball Canada for two (2) consecutive years, will lose their current certification level, and be demoted one level

For the 2020–21 season, there will be a moratorium on this particular aspect of the referee policies with resumption to occur in the 2021–22 season.
