

# 2024 Team Alberta North Coaching Positions

The Mat-Su <u>2024 Arctic Winter Games</u> includes athletes from Northern Alberta, Northwest Territories, Yukon, Nunavut, Alaska, Greenland, Nunavik (Northern Quebec), and the Indigenous people (Sami) of Norway, Sweden and Finland. Volleyball Alberta is currently seeking qualified coaches, **living north of the 55**<sup>th</sup> **parallel** (<u>Map</u>, <u>Communities</u>) for each of the following positions:

#### Women's Team Head Coach (1) & Assistant Coach (1) Men's Team Head Coach (1) & Assistant Coach (1)

Duties to include but are not limited to:

- Work with Volleyball Alberta staff to organize, plan and facilitate selection camp(s) in December 2023
- Contribute to team selection process as part of a selection committee (minimum 3 person committee, including coaches)
- Work with Volleyball Alberta staff to organize, plan and facilitate two training camps (January-March), prior to the Arctic Winter Games
- Coaching and preparation of the team for the Arctic Winter Games March 10-16, 2024 (Mat-Su Borough, Alaska)
- Leading the team in accordance with Volleyball Alberta, Team Alberta North and the Arctic Winter Games philosophy and policies
- Supervision of athletes throughout the training and competition period

### Criteria for Selection:

- NCCP Certification Development Coach Certified or higher
- Safe Sport Training, Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation, Making Headway in Sport, Foundations of Volleyball eLearning
- Previous coaching and related experience
- Previous commitment and contribution to the development of volleyball
- Performance in an interview, if deemed necessary by the selection committee

#### Your Application Should Include:

- A detailed **<u>coaching resume</u>** highlighting your coaching background, related experience, and current level of NCCP certification.
- <u>A letter</u> stating which team you would be interested in coaching, the preferred position, and your motivation for coaching with Team Alberta North and a description of what you can provide to the program.

The successful applicant will be required to obtain a clear Vulnerable Sector Police Information Check as per Volleyball Alberta's <u>Screening Requirements</u>.
