The maximum team size shall be:

4 Athletes per Zone (# of females 2 # of males 2)

2 coaches or chaperones (# of females 1 # of males 1)

# FILL POLICY

The first opportunity to fill is provided to the Host Zone.

The second opportunity to fill is provided to the Zone with the greatest participation at their respective selection camp.

Fills must be submitted for approval to the Multisport Games Unit by June 20, 2023

# ELIGIBILITY

#### Athletes

- 16U Athletes born September 1, 2006 or later
- Athletes must tryout in the Zone in which he/she resides.

### Coaches

- One Head Coach will be selected for each Zone to coach the boys' and girls' team. The coach must be registered member with Volleyball Alberta and have completed thefollowing: Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation, Making Head Way online modules, Safe Sport Training, Developmenmt Coach Workshop and the Foundations of Volleyball ELearning. Coaches must also complete Volleyball Alberta screening requirements. It is recommended that the Head coach has experience coaching beach volleyball.
  - Chaperones must also complete Safe Sport Training and screening requirements
- All coaches and chaperones must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of the Alberta Games.

# AFFILIATION

- Athletes and coaches must be registered as full members with Volleyball Alberta. The cost of affiliation can be found at: <u>https://www.volleyballalberta.ca/registration-fees-and-benefits</u>
- Athletes must represent the Alberta Games Zone in which they reside. The SPAR Branch Zones by Community List will be used to confirm Zone of residence.
- Upon qualifying for the Zone team, players will be charged an additional fee (above the Provincial Games Registration Fee) to cover the costs associated with the team. This fee will be determined by Volleyball Alberta and will be announced with the tryout information.



# ALBERTA GAMES – ATHLETE REGISTRATION FEE AND DEADLINE

All Zone team athletes who qualify to compete at the 2023 Alberta Summer Games are required to pay an individual registration fee. This fee will offset the costs related to transportation, accommodation, meals, Zone identification, medals, athlete entertainment and sport competitions. This fee must accompany the athlete's registration form for the Provincial Games. Volleyball Alberta will be responsible for collecting the registration fee and then providing one payment for all following the completion of the Alberta Games.
