

VOLLEYBALL ALBERTA SUMMER CAMPS – ASSISTANT COACH JOB DESCRIPTION

Volleyball Alberta is seeking qualified individuals for the position of Head Coach for their Edmonton, Grimshaw, Calgary and Sylvan Lake Volleyball Camps. There are multiple positions available during each week in Edmonton & Sylvan, allowing the Head Coaches to work with Assistants and Jr Coaches to expand their knowledge of the sport.

We are looking for coaches for 6 weeks of camps with training starting in the first week of July and the last camp will end on August 14th. Travel to the different cities will be required for those who are hired for the full 6-weeks.

Assistant Coaches are expected to have had some coaching experience in the past and be willing to learn from others. Assistant Coaches are often individuals that have acted as an assistant coach or head coach for at least one year, or are varsity athletes in their first, second, or third year of eligibility.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist Head Coaches (practice planning, drill implementation, etc.)
- Assist all athletes (expectations, skill development, feedback, etc.)
- Build relationships with each athlete and coach within the camp.
- Be enthusiastic, energetic, positive, empathetic, and understanding to athletes and coaches
- Be a role model

ON-COURT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in skill demonstrations
- Implementation of the practice plan made by the Head Coach for your skill group
- Drill management & execution
- Assist athletes (feedback, correction, positive reinforcement, etc.)
- Monitor the safety and improvement of on-court athletes
- Work with coaches in supporting the teaching & learning of skills

OFF-COURT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in coach debriefs and willing to learn/take feedback
- Participate in classroom sessions
- Supervision of athletes (day & night)
- Lead and participate in camp social/recreational activities
- Provide leadership & instruction to athletes
- Complete athlete evaluations
- 100% commitment to Camp Rules and Regulations to provide a safe environment for athlete and coaches

Other responsibilities may be asked of the Assistant Coach by the Volleyball Alberta Camp Directors. These may include responsibilities such as assistance during a medical emergency, supervision, etc.
