



2026 Alberta Summer Games- Beach Volleyball Coaching Positions

Volleyball Alberta is seeking qualified individuals to serve as Head Coaches for the boys' and girls' beach volleyball teams at Alberta Summer Games. The Games will be held July 16-19, 2026 in Strathcona County. Visit the [Alberta Summer Games website](#) for more information.

Each Zone we will need 1 Head Coach per [Zone](#) for each gender.

General Qualifications:

- Organization of the selections/tryouts
- Organizing, planning and executing a training plan leading up to the Games
- Training selected teams approximately 4 hours/week from the selection camp until the Games
- Attendance and supervision of the athletes for the entirety of the Games, inclusive of overnight supervision in the dorms, July 16-19, 2026

Position Specific Qualifications:

- **NCCP Certification** - Coaches must be fully Certified to a minimum Volleyball Development Coach in the National Coaching Certification (NCCP) Program.
- **Person in Authority Checks** - All coaches and chaperones must complete and submit to the Provincial Sport Coordinator prior to commencing their role:
 - A clear criminal records and vulnerable sector check from within the last three (3) years
 - A clear Screening Disclosure Form upon registering in Sportlomo.
 - Completion of CAC Safe Sport Training.
- Leader – Club/Team Personnel – Head Coach Membership
- *All coaches and chaperones must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of the Alberta Games*

Responsibilities and Duties

- **Team Selection:** Evaluate athletes alongside a selection committee at tryouts to select the best players.
- **Training Program Development:** Design and implement training focused on skill development, and strategic gameplay.
- **Game Strategy:** Develop and communicate game plans, ensuring athletes understand their roles.
- **Performance Assessment:** Regularly assess player performance and provide constructive feedback.
- **Leadership:** Foster a positive and motivating team environment to encourage athletes.



- **Communication:** Ensure open communication with athletes and parents with clear expectations and individual progress. Collaborate with athletes' participation in other activities/sports to manage training loads and limit conflicts.
- **Logistics Organization:** Manage practice schedules, competition logistics, and travel arrangements.
- **Safety Assurance:** Ensure a safe training environment and adhere to health protocols.
- **Sportsmanship Promotion:** Instill values of fair play and sportsmanship in athletes.
