- Passionate for working with children and youth in recreational and physical activity settings.
- Knowledge in the Canadian Sport for Life and Long-Term Development Model
- Prior knowledge of volleyball (tactical/technical)
- Ability to effectively communicate with children and parents
- Responsible and reliable
- Strong interpersonal, time-management skills
- Reliable form of transportation

Head Coach Qualifications

- Must have at least 2 years' experience of coaching volleyball to youth (mix of assistant or head coach position)
- Working towards to having a degree in physical education or coaching is an asset
- Experience in putting together volleyball practice plans
- Have done or are willing to do either the Smashball Coach Workshop, Elementary Volleyball eLearning or Foundations of Volleyball eLearning.
- Have experience, in any context, teaching/coaching kids ages 6-12
- Current First Aid/ CPR or willing to get trained
- Must have an NCCP number

Assistant Coach Qualifications

- Must have 1 year of assistant coach experience in volleyball
- Have experience, in any context, teaching/coaching kids ages 6-12
- NCCP sport training is an asset
- Current First Aid/ CPR or willing to get trained
- Must have an NCCP number

Junior Coach Qualifications

- Passionate for working with children and youth in recreational and physical activity settings
- Prior knowledge of volleyball (tactical/technical)
- Some experience working with kids ages 6-12 is considered an asset

Responsibilities and Duties

- Please note either a Head or Assistant, at either the GO Sports Program, you will be responsible for the following:
 - Demonstrate and model appropriate behaviors as reflected in Volleyball Alberta's Mission, Vision and Values
 - Participation in Coach Training
 - Program Attendance
 - Meeting with the coaching team in advance to discuss your practice plan.
 - Implementing and evaluating drills for your designated group.
 - Demonstration of technical volleyball skills to large groups of participants
 - Participating and contributing to all items listed in the lesson plan in a positive way.
 - Managing specific court set up/take down (if needed).
 - Cleaning up the gym floor of any garbage that might have occurred during your program.
 - Putting all practice plans into the GO Program google drive under your specific programs
 - Supervision of breaks or leisure time of the athletes.
 - Create a safe and welcoming environment for children to engage in.
 - Communicate in a professional manner with all staff, children and parents.
 - Other duties the Early Stages Coordinator may need for the program
