



VOLLEYBALL ALBERTA SUMMER CAMPS - HEAD COACH JOB DESCRIPTION

Volleyball Alberta is seeking qualified individuals for the position of Head Coach for their Edmonton, Grimshaw, Rocky Mountain House, Calgary and Sylvan Lake Volleyball Camps. There are multiple positions available during each week in Edmonton, Rocky Mountain House & Sylvan, allowing the Head Coaches to work with Assistants and Jr Coaches to expand their knowledge of the sport.

We are looking for coaches for 6 weeks of camps with training starting in the first week of July and the last camp will end on August 20th. Travel to the different cities will be required for those who are hired for the full 6-weeks.

Head Coaches are expected to have had a wealth of coaching experience in the past and be willing to learn from others. Head Coaches are often individuals that have acted as an assistant coach or head coach for two or more years, are varsity athletes in their fourth or fifth year of eligibility or have experience coaching at VA (Volleyball Alberta) summer camps in the past.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist all Coaches (practice planning, drill implementation, etc.)
- Assist all athletes (expectations, skill development, feedback, etc.)
- Build relationships with each athlete and coach within the camp.
- Be enthusiastic, energetic, positive, empathetic, and understanding to athletes and coaches
- Be a role model for all athletes & coaches

ON-COURT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Create and implement a practice plan specific to your skill group
- Supervise the development of Assistant Coaches and Junior Coaches (feedback, drill execution, drill adaptation, supporting the teaching & learning of skills, etc.)
- Lead and participate in skill demonstrations
- Assist athletes (feedback, correction, positive reinforcement, etc.)

OFF-COURT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Practice & demonstration planning with Mentor Coach while being able to take feedback
- Participate in coach debriefs at breaks or end of day
- Lead or participate in classroom sessions
- Lead and participate in camp social/recreational activities
- Supervision of athletes (day & night for SLVC)
- Provide leadership & instruction to athletes
- Complete athlete evaluations
- 100% commitment to Camp Rules and Regulations to provide a safe environment for athlete and coaches

Other responsibilities may be asked of the Head Coach by the Volleyball Alberta Summer Camp Coordinators. These may include responsibilities such as assistance during a medical emergency, supervision, etc.
