



VOLLEYBALL ALBERTA SUMMER CAMPS - JUNIOR COACH JOB DESCRIPTION

Volleyball Alberta is seeking qualified individuals for the position of Head Coach for their Edmonton, Grimshaw, Calgary and Sylvan Lake Volleyball Camps. There are multiple positions available during each week in Edmonton & Sylvan, allowing the Head Coaches to work with Assistants and Jr Coaches to expand their knowledge of the sport.

We are looking for coaches for 6 weeks of camps with training starting in the first week of July and the last camp will end on August 20th. Travel to the different cities will be required for those who are hired for the full 6-weeks.

Junior Coaches are not expected to have any coaching experience, but must be passionate about the sport and be eager to learn from others. Junior Coaches are often are mature U17/U18 club players, or varsity athletes in their first/second year of eligibility.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist all Assistant/Head Coaches (drill implementation, court management, etc.)
- Assist all athletes (expectations, skill development, feedback, etc.)
- Build relationships with each athlete and coach
- A focus on being enthusiastic, energetic & positive.
- Be a role model

ON-COURT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in skill demonstrations
- Expectation to either survey all courts for opportunities to help in practice plan execution, drill implementation, or court management, or report to their HC or AC who are in need of assistance.
- Drill management & execution
- Assist athletes (feedback, correction, positive reinforcement, etc. Monitor the safety and improvement on-court athletes
- Work with coaches in supporting the teaching & learning of skills
- Monitor the safety and improvement of on-court athletes

OFF-COURT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in coach debriefs, a time to educate yourself and learn as much as possible
- Participate in classroom sessions
- Lead and participate in camp social/recreational activities
- Supervision of athletes (day & night)
- Provide leadership & instruction to athletes
- 100% commitment to Camp Rules and Regulations to provide a safe environment for athlete and coaches

Other responsibilities may be asked of the Junior Coach by the Volleyball Alberta Camp Directors. These may include responsibilities such as assistance during a medical emergency, supervision, etc.
